SESSION 8 DISCUSSION GUIDE

THE MILLENNIUM AND JUDGMENT DAY

Summary - Revelation 20 (18 minutes)

The dragon (Satan) is seized, bound, and thrown into the Abyss for one thousand years (Revelation 20:1-3).

The Millennium is a time when the church will rule with King Jesus on Earth, while Satan is bound.

At the end of the Millennium, Satan will be released, form an army, and prepare for another battle with God and His people at Gog and Magog (Revelation 20:7-9).

Satan is captured and thrown in the Lake of Fire, as were the Antichrist and the False Prophet, to be tormented forever (Revelation 20:10).

The Great White Throne Judgement takes place (Revelation 20:11-15).

Discussion Questions - After discussing what you learned from the teaching, use the following questions to have further conversation.

1. As Pastor Drew shared, in what ways will life be different during the Millennium? How will there be people who are ready to rebel against God?

What does this remind us about human nature and sin?

2. As Christians, since we know Hell, or “the lake of fire”, is real, why is it so difficult to talk about this with unbelievers? How would you respond to someone who says, “A loving God wouldn’t have a place like Hell”?

THE NEW HEAVEN AND THE NEW EARTH

Summary - Revelation 21-22 (21 minutes)

The new heaven and a new earth descend and now God dwells among His people forever (Revelation 21:1-5)!

There will be no more death, mourning, crying, pain, or tears!

Eden is restored with full access to the Tree of Life (Revelation 22:1-4).

“I am coming soon!” These words are trustworthy and true (Revelation 22:17-21)!

Discussion Questions

1. It has been said, “Humanity has been hoping for a new heaven and a new earth ever since Adam and Eve in the Garden of Eden.” After reading the passages above, how does the end of Revelation ultimately fulfill or complete the entire story of the Bible?
2. What are you looking forward to most in the “new heaven and new earth?”
3. If you had to pinpoint the most important takeaway from this 8-session study on the book of Revelation, what would you say it is?
