Key Responsibilities:

- Attend CFSEU's Leadership Impact Project presentation day to listen to each candidate's presentation.
- Provide constructive and encouraging written and verbal feedback to candidates based on predetermined criteria, such as:
 - Clarity and effectiveness of communication
 - Quality of content and relevance to leadership
 - Demonstration of strategic thinking and problem-solving abilities
 - Ability to inspire and motivate others
 - Overall presentation skills and professionalism
- Collaborate with fellow panel members
- Maintain confidentiality regarding CFSEU student information and feedback discussions

Qualifications:
