You've stepped across the line of faith and invited Jesus to come into your life. You are forgiven and have eternal life.




We get baptized to show people we love Jesus. Share the wedding ring example with your child to help them understand this.

"If you love Me, keep My commandments."



Baptism shows people you belong to Jesus.

"For as many of you as have been baptized into Christ have put on Christ like a garment." Galatians 3:27



Baptism shows people what Jesus has done for you.




"For you were buried with Christ when you were baptized.

Why Should I be Baptized?

Discussion Questions

Talk through these questions with your child to make sure he/she understands.

- A. Renee was baptized as a baby. She's now 9 years old and has invited Jesus into her life. Should she be baptized? Why or why not?
- B. Terrance thinks if he is baptized his sins will be forgiven. Is he correct? Why or why not?
- C. What does baptism show people?
- D. How does baptism represent Jesus dying, being buried and rising again for you?
- F. How does being baptized help you grow in your faith?
- E. Carlos wants to be baptized because he saw his friend get baptized and he thinks it looks fun. Is this a good reason to be baptized? Why or why not?

F. NO. Baptism is for people who have made a decision to follow Jesus.

E. It's the first step of obedience as a follower of Jesus.

D. When you stand in the water, it makes the shape of a cross like Jesus died on. When you go under the water, it represents Jesus grave. When you come up out of the water, it represents Jesus rising from the dead.

C. It shows you love Jesus and belong to Him.

B. NO. Baptism does not forgive your sins. Your sins are forgiven when you ask Jesus to come into your life.

A. YES. Believer's baptism happens after you're old enough to understand and have invited Jesus into your life.

Answers:



Why do you go under the water when you are baptized?

The word "baptize" means to go under. When Jesus was buried, His entire body went down in the grave and so we go all the way under the water to show this.

I'm nervous about being baptized. Is this normal?

Yes. Some kids are nervous about people watching them or about going under the water. Just remember, Jesus will be with you and everyone there is cheering for you.

Cetting Ready for Baptism

Write down what you're going to say on the "I'm Getting Baptized" card and bring it with you to your baptism.

Help your child write out why he/she is being baptized. There is a card in your parent packet for this.

When you are baptized, we'd like to give you the opportunity to tell people why you are being baptized. Here are some examples of things you can say:

- · I want to show people that Jesus has come into my life.
- I want to show people that Jesus is my Forgiver, Leader and Friend.
- I want people to know that Jesus has forgiven my sins and I love Him.

Parents FAQ's

My child was baptized as a baby. Does he/she need to be baptized now?

Yes. In the bible, believer's baptism was always for people who were old enough to understand and make their own decision about being baptized.

How do I know if my child is ready to be baptized?

Here's some things to watch for...

- Your child has made a clear decision to invite Jesus into their life.
- Your child has a clear understanding of what baptism means. Go over the discussion questions on page 8 with them.
- Your child is persistent in bringing up the subject on a regular basis.
- Your child feels this is something they need to do vs. something they want to do. There is a difference.

My child wants to be baptized, but doesn't have a clear understanding
of what it means yet? What should I do.

Continue sharing with them and let them kniw you're proud of them for taking steps toward being baptized.
