Your **Group or Class Members** may look to you as a **Group Leader** to gain clarity from weekend messages or announcements, and they will see you as their closest connection to church leadership. We encourage you to stay informed through church emails and updates on the church website.

Group/Class Coaches will connect with you regularly to mentor, encourage, and pray for you and your group members. Serving as a Group Leader puts you on the front line of ministry. Keeping a close relationship with your Group Coach and asking questions will help you grow as a leader. Maintaining contact with your Coach can usually prevent unnecessary stressors from occurring in your group such as conflict, unhealthy behaviors, and/or real safety concerns. Any time there is a question relating to the physical, emotional, or mental health of a group member, contact your Group Coach.

Campus Groups & Classes Staff are Christ Fellowship staff members who are praying for you and committed to support you and invest in your leadership. They will provide training and resources to equip and empower you as a leader. In the event that a group member has a need that is beyond the span of care that a Study or Activity Group can provide, you have support from our Freedom and Care team (DivorceCare, GriefShare, Celebrate Recovery or Cancer Support). These ministries can provide a needed rest stop for a group member's journey to the full life that God has promised. Freedom & Care.
