

## Three Ways to Build Your Group or Table Group:

### 1) PERSONAL INVITE

Invite people you know and would like to get to know better.

- Familiar faces at church - people who sit near you during church services or other events or you see when you drop off your children at Christ Fellowship Kids or CFStudents.
- Familiar places - neighbors, co-workers, or people you see at the gym or your child's school or activities.
- Familiar names - from social media groups and online communities that you've connected with. Your campus Groups & Classes team can provide you with images to share on social media.

### 2) RECRUITING

Be intentional about meeting people who are looking to connect into church life by joining a group:

- Serve as a Table Leader for a class where people are looking to get connected in a group – either locally or virtually.
- Serve at a Semester Connect Weekend and share information on your specific group or class with people looking to connect in a new group.
- Participate in a 4th Saturday Serve to meet people who connect through outreach or serving opportunities and invite them to connect in your group.

### 3) OPEN GROUP

Allow your group to be featured on the Groups & Classes Finder for people who might search for a group on the Christ Fellowship website or App. Once your group grows to the desired size, you can notify your campus Groups & Classes staff member who can move the group to “private” so it no longer appears on the Groups & Classes Finder.
