“There is a time for everything, and a season for every activity under the heavens.” Ecclesiastes 3:1

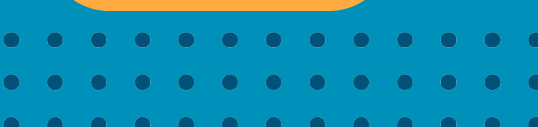
ASK MYSELF: “Even when I have prepared in advance, am I committed to remaining flexible in my attitude and actions if and when circumstances change?”

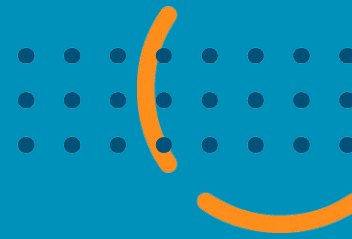


What I’m a Part of is Bigger Than the Part I Play - Alignment Matters!
