

# KEEP TALKING

## SERMON HIGHLIGHTS

- **Deconstruction:** The process of reexamining beliefs, practices, and assumptions you've inherited about God, Scripture, the Church, and Christianity.
- Christianity is not just *spiritually meaningful*; it is also *intellectually credible*.
- **Prophecy:** A message inspired by God and communicated through a human vessel to reveal God's truth, God's heart, God's will, or God's purposes to people.
- Make God's Word your final authority.
- Stop picking the parts you prefer.
- Don't just believe the Truth — Live the Truth.
