

KEEP TALKING

In this brand-new series, Pastor Ryan explored Moses' encounter with God at the burning bush and reminded us that God's calling doesn't hinge on our ability but on His presence and power. Use this guide to keep talking about Sunday's message.

SERMON HIGHLIGHTS

- Our goal is not to meditate on Moses' life, but to meet with the God who marked him.
- God has a *specific* and *significant* calling on your life.
- The greatest answer to the future is not information; it's a greater revelation of who God is.
- Our responsibility is obedience; God's responsibility is the outcome.
- The burning bush wasn't the starting point of Moses' story—it was the turning point.

KEY SCRIPTURES

- Exodus 3:1-16
- Exodus 4:1-17

START TALKING

- What's a job, responsibility, or challenge you've taken on that you felt completely unqualified for at first?

KEEP TALKING

- What was your biggest takeaway from this message?
- Pastor Ryan said, "One moment in God's presence can change your life forever." Can you think of a moment or season when you sensed God changing the direction of your life?
- Of the five objections Moses listed—"Who am I?" "Who are You?" "What if they don't believe me?" "I don't have what it takes." "Please send someone else."—which one do you most resonate with right now and why?
- Pastor Ryan challenged us to consider what's already "in our hand." What gifts, opportunities, or relationships has God already given you that He might want to use for His purposes?
- What is one step of obedience God may be inviting you to take this week, even if you don't feel completely ready? What would trusting Him look like in that situation?

KEEP IT GOING

- Spend time meditating on Exodus 3-4 this week. Ask God to reveal more of who He is, and pray for the courage to say "yes" wherever He's calling you to trust and obey.

PRAYER

Father, thank You for promising to always be with us. Holy Spirit, we ask for fresh courage this week. Courage to act. Courage to obey. Courage to take a step of faith. We don't want our objections to hinder our obedience. We love You. Help us trust You more. Amen.
