

KEEP TALKING

In this message, Pastor Tyler Gay continued our series about Moses by exploring Israel's journey through the Red Sea and showing how God can make a way—even when there seems to be no way. Use this guide to keep talking about Sunday's message.

KEY SCRIPTURES

- Exodus 14:10; 13-14; 19-22
- 2 Timothy 1:7
- Psalm 112:7
- Isaiah 55:9

START TALKING

- What's the most memorable road trip, vacation, or adventure you've ever been on? What made it unforgettable?

KEEP TALKING

- What was your biggest takeaway from this message?
- Pastor Tyler described a "Red Sea moment" as feeling trapped between an impossible situation behind you and an impassable obstacle in front of you. Have you ever experienced a season like that? What did you learn?
- Read Exodus 14:13-14. Moses told the Israelites, "Do not be afraid. Stand firm... The Lord will fight for you; you need only to be still." Which part of that instruction speaks to you most right now? Why?
- Pastor Tyler reminded us that "God is working even when we can't see it." Looking back, can you identify a time when God was working behind the scenes before you realized it?
- What is one area of your life where you need to stop trying to control the outcome and trust God to make a way?

KEEP IT GOING

- This week, spend a few minutes each day remembering how God has been faithful in the past. Write down one way you've seen Him provide, protect, or make a way before—and let those reminders strengthen your faith for whatever you're facing right now.

Father, thank You for making a way when there seems to be no way. When fear tries to overwhelm us, help us stand firm, lift our eyes to You, and trust that You are working even when we can't see it. Thank You for always being with us by day and by night. We love You and trust You. Amen.
